CHALKING THE DOOR The Epiphany House Blessing

"Chalking the door" is a centuries-old custom in which Christians gather on the feast of the Epiphany to ask God's blessing on their home.

A traditional way of doing this is to take a piece of blessed chalk and inscribe above the entrance door to the home.

20+C+M+B+26

The "20" and "26" refer to the actual year. The "+" between the letters symbolizes the cross of Christ.

The "C M B" initials have two meanings:

- 1. The initials represent the three Magi: Casper, Melchior and Balthazar.*
- 2. Also, the initials abbreviate the Latin "Christus mansionem benedict" (May Christ bless this house).]*
