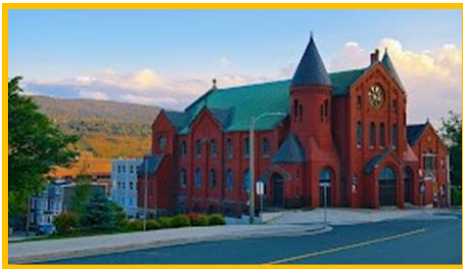




St. John's United Church NEWSLETTER 2025
