## FIFTH LENTEN CANDLE READING

During lent, we remember the events that led up to the crucifixion. Jesus had come into the world to bring hope and light, but at every step there was those who could not accept the power of that light. He came to create a new relationship between God and human beings, but there were those who had other ideas. Because he could not be manipulated, they sought to kill him. In the Gospel of Matthew we read: when Jesus had finished teaching, he said to his disciples, in two days, as you know, it will be the Passover festival and the son of man will be handed over to be crucified. The chief priest and the elders met together in the palace of Caiaphas, the high priest, had made plans to arrest Jesus secretly and put him to death. "We must not do it during the festival", they said, "or the people will riot". Then one of the twelve disciples, the one named Judas Iscariot, went to the chief priests and asked, "what will you give me if I betray Jesus to you".

## They counted out 30 silver coins and gave them to him. From then on, Judas was looking for a good chance to hand Jesus over to them.

Reader: Betrayed by a kiss from a friend for 30 pieces of silver ... Anyone could have been the one, Jesus came as the truth, but the light was too brilliant for those who liked the darkness. As the small bags of coins were traded from hand to hand a little of the light that come into the world was snuffed out.
