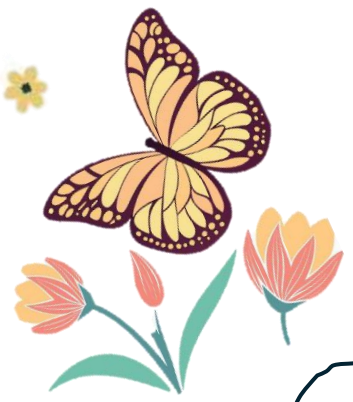

Monetary donations are also appreciated, any donation of \$ 25.00 or more will receive a tax receipt. These donations go directly to help members in our community

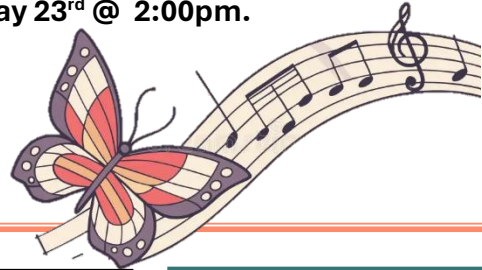
